

SPORIFY 23.1.1 Is Coming!



We are pleased to let you know that SPORIFY 23.1.1 will be released over the weekend of July 8th-9th. This minor release responds to upcoming changes that EMA is making to its SPOR OMS API.

From July 12th, EMA will employ an API request rate limiting mechanism that allows a maximum of 60 requests per minute per user and 1000 requests per minute and for all users over the full SPOR user base. This applies to SPOR OMS ORG and LOC API endpoints that are used during the SPORIFY daily sync.

While we are attempting to limit the impact of this EMA SPOR API rate limiting for SPORIFY users we do anticipate that this will result in slower sync times for OMS data. We currently do not have any estimate of how much longer an OMS daily sync will take but we will monitor this closely over the next days, weeks and months and report back to EMA any issues we find with this new rate limiting mechanism.

With SPORIFY 23.1.1, we have enhanced our OMS sync to work with the latest SPOR API changes and as part of this minor release we have also taken the opportunity to include some security patches as well as bug fixes.

Details of all minor updates can be found in the release notes section of the SPORIFY menu.

For SPORIFY customers subscribed to the SPORIFY validation environment, all associated validation documentation for this release will also be available in the validation environment via the navigation menu.
